



Money from recent housing developments in Axminster - Section 106 funding - available for outdoor sports.

If you're an Axminster resident, club, group or organisation and have an idea for how you could spend some of this funding on an outdoor sports facility then tell us about it.

Axminster Town and East Devon District Councils are inviting everyone in the town to send in their ideas on how to spend the money.

Proposals must be for:

- New outdoor sports facilities or to improve existing outdoor sports facilities. Buildings are not eligible.
- Permanently sited sports facilities and equipment. Not for movable equipment like cricket bats, kayaks or tennis rackets.
- Sports facilities or equipment that is open and accessible to the community. A small fee may be charged but it must be affordable.

Once the town council has received the proposals they will work with East Devon to make sure they are eligible, affordable and possible.
