PUBLIC FORUM FOR TRAFFIC MATTERS: A member of the public re-iterated his concerns regarding the problem of speeding in Lyme Street/Lyme Road which he had been raising over the past three years and which remained unresolved. He felt that the recent incident in which a man had lost a leg should serve to highlight the seriousness of the problem. It was pointed out by one Councillor that the matter had been one of road rage rather than the direct result of speeding. Other Councillors mentioned the problems caused by west bound traffic failing to observe the current priority system installed for the duration of scaffolding works at The Joinery.
